## **IN CASE OF LOST PASSPORTS**

After submission of documentary requirements, there is a prescribed clearing period of 15 days prior to issuance of replacement. It will take another forty (40) working days before the new/replacement passport is released. All passports shall be replaced only upon receipt of confirmation from DFA-Manila. And once passport is declared lost or stolen, it is automatically deemed cancelled and that if found, it can no longer be used to avoid complications with immigration authorities.

3. Immigration Report, if needed (i.e. renewal of working visa)
4. Copy of lost passport
5. New DFA Authenticated PSA Birth Certificate
6. New DFA Authenticated PSA Marriage Certificate (if lost passport is under husband's surname)
7. Copy of Philippine issued IDs
8. Other documents that are deemed necessary
